

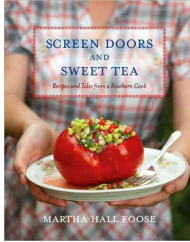
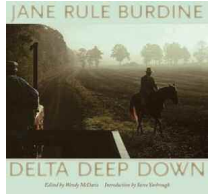


## GIFTS FROM HOME

### SCREEN DOORS AND SWEET TEA

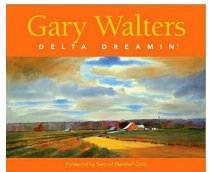
MARTHA FOOSE

### FIRST SHOOTING LIGHT

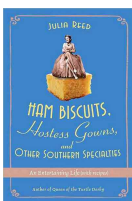
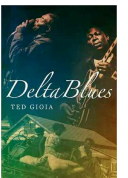

JULIA REED

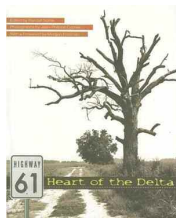
